American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Origin

- Enacted on March 11, 2021
- State and Local fiscal relief
- Flexible funding
- Allocation formula
- Reporting requirements



CT DPH's Focus on Lead Poisoning and Removal of Lead Hazards



- Long-term Effectiveness
- Regulatory compliance
- Ethical responsibility

Allocation of Funds: \$30 Million

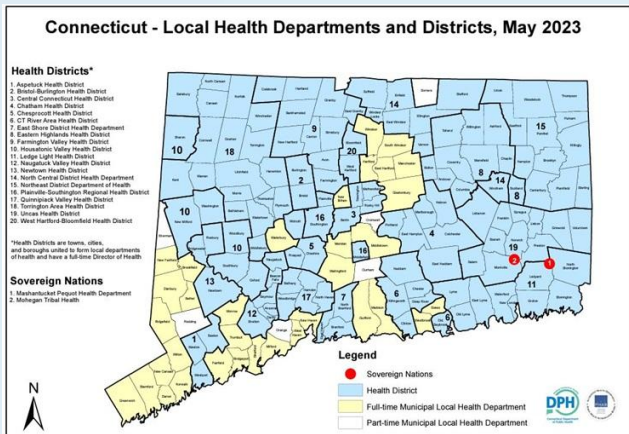
Reimbursement to Local Health Departments

- Reimbursement designed to cover the cost of comprehensive lead inspections

Awarded to qualified Fiduciary

- Fiduciary will subcontract with lead abatement contractors

Reimbursing LHDs



- Timely Intervention
- Secondary Preventative Action
- Supports Future Investigations
